Nomination & Election of 2020 SAAZ Officers

Per to the current bylaws, **the election is held at the December meeting** (usually the Christmas Party, which is why we hope to change this in the bylaws for next year). **Nominations are still open, right up to when we hold the election.** Submit in person at the election meeting (Christmas Party) or via email to secretary@saaz.org AND president@saaz.org (copy both). You may nominate someone else with their permission or self-nominate.

Read through the board position descriptions and responsibilities in the current bylaws. Also feel free to talk with current board members to get a feel for what's involved. Don't be shy... it's a team effort and we'll help transition any new board members. Board members are expected to attend monthly board meetings (which always include food and beer, of course) and to attend most SAAZ activities, though we understand that everyone can't always make them all.
